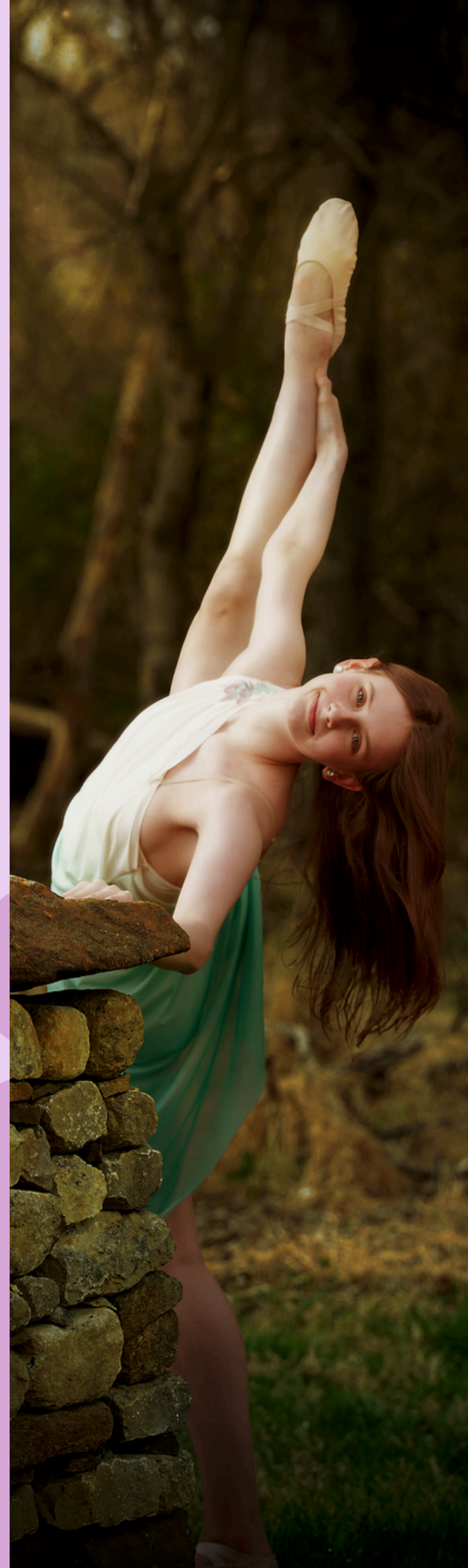

Loudoun Contemporary Dance Company

May 17, 2026 - Auditions \$25/dancer

- 12:00-12:30 pm: Pre-Apprentices & Mini's (Rising Jazz I-II)
- 12:30-1:00 pm: Jr. Apprentices (Rising Jazz III-IV)
- 1:00-1:30 pm: Apprentices (Rising Jazz V-VI)
- 1:30-2:00 pm: 1st & 2nd Company (Rising Jazz VII-X)

Pre-Apprentices and Mini's

- A minimum of 2 years of Ballet and Jazz - Pre-Apprentices
- A minimum of 1 year of Ballet and Jazz - Mini's
- Must have completed Jazz I, II or III - Pre-Apprentices
- Must have completed a rising stars combo class or Jazz I - Mini's
- Must be six years old by September 30, 2026

Junior Apprentices (1st & 2nd Companies)

- A minimum of 3 years of Ballet
- Completed Jazz III or IV
- Dancers must be nine years old by September 30, 2026

Apprentices (1st & 2nd Companies)

- A minimum of 4 years of Ballet
- Completed Jazz IV, V, VI
- Dancers must be 10 years old by September 30, 2026

Company Dancers (1st & 2nd Companies)

- A minimum of 5 years of Ballet
- Completed Jazz VI, VII, VIII, IX, or X
- Dancers must be 13 years old by September 30, 2026

Loudoun Ballet Performing Arts Company

May 17, 2026 - Auditions \$25/dancer

- 2:00-2:30 pm: Jr. Apprentices
- 2:30-3:00 pm: Apprentices
- 3:00-3:45 pm: Company Dancers

Junior Apprentices

- A minimum of 3 years of Ballet
- Completing ballet Ballet IV, and a minimum of 2.5 hours of Ballet per week
- Dancers must be nine years old by September 30, 2026

Apprentices

- A minimum of 1 year of Pointe and/or Pre-pointe,
- Four years of Ballet - or completed ballet V, VI, or VII
- 5 1/2 hours of Intermediate levels of Ballet per week
- Dancers must be 11 years of age by September 30, 2026

Company Members

- A minimum of 2 years of Pointe
- Six years of Ballet - must have completed Ballet VIII and enrolled in Ballet IX or X
- 5 1/2 hours of advanced levels of Ballet per week
- Dancers must be 13 years of age by September 30, 2026
