Rising Stars Recital Information

Everything you need to know:

Our Winter Rising Stars Department Recital, "Dancing Through The Decades," will be held on January 28, 2023, at Loudoun Valley High School in Purcellville, VA. Stage rehearsal will be on Friday, January 27, between 5-7:30 pm. October 8 is the last day to purchase the winter recital costumes without a late fee. A late order option will be available through November 15. Tickets will be available for purchase at the studio starting in January 2023 and at the performance on show day. Tickets are \$15/per person.





NYCDA & ASH

Each year, our Loudoun Contemporary Dance Co dancers attend the workshops and competitions at New York City Dance Alliance and Artist Simply Human. Attendance for the *workshops* is **open to all** Loudoun School of Ballet dancers enrolled in contemporary department classes.

NYCDA & ASH are high-caliber dance conventions that we attend annually, and any dancer from the school may attend.

WORKSHOP CLASSES: Workshop classes are held Friday evening at NYCDA (optional) and Saturday and Sunday at NYCDA and ASH. The classes run approx. 8:00 am - 2:00/2:30pm. Classes are held in Jazz, Ballet, Tap, Lyrical, Contemporary, Hip Hop, and occasionally other genres like Ballroom. You don't need previous training in any genre other than Ballet and Jazz but are expected to take every class except tap. Saturday begins in the largest Ballroom with a welcome rally where teachers are introduced. From there, the minis, juniors, teens, and seniors separate. The teachers rotate to the students. There is often a half-day program for even younger dancers.

PARENT OBSERVERS: Parents who want to watch the workshop must pay an observer fee.

COMPETITION: The Competitions are held Friday and Saturday evenings. Generally, Friday night is the solo competition. LCDC and Loudon Taps will compete at both NYCDA and ASH this season. **SCHOLARSHIP AUDITION:** All dancers participate in an audition for convention Scholarships. This is held during the workshop and is relatively low-key. Parents may not observe. Awarded scholarships are given out range from single convention scholarships (to attend the workshop free the following year) to scholarships that give a student the opportunity to compete on a National level in the summer. The scholarship auditions are not the focus of our weekend.

CONVENTION FINALE: The Convention Finale follows the workshop classes on Sunday and includes performances and Scholarship awards. This is held in the main Ballroom. Parents may watch the Convention Finale for free.

SCHEDULE: The class and competition schedules do not come out until a week or so prior to the convention.

REGISTRATION: Registration for the convention is done through the school, with checks being made to The Loudoun School of Ballet or charged to your card on file. The convention name should be noted in the subject line. Registration forms are at the desk and are due by October 15.
